CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A[red oak]: Harvest all merchantable red oak and mixed hardwood within the designated boundaries except for 1) teal marked trees (leave trees), 2) all aspen and 3) all conifers. All unmerchantable stems >1", except aspen and conifers, shall be severed. (81 acres) *Access, roads & landings:*

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed for hauling.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- Decking of wood allowed along the Gardner Lake fire lane as long as the decked wood does not extend out onto the road surface.

Seasonal restrictions:

➤ No harvesting activity from April 1st through July 15th. Oak wilt restrictions.

BMP's:

No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands, ephemeral ponds, open water or designated stream channels. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands, except during frozen conditions.

Slas<u>h:</u>

- Logger is encouraged to leave large tops on site away from residual trees.
- Proposed Oak burn site: No slash will be allowed within 10 ft of the residual trees and no large slash piles will be allowed onsite.
- No slash will be allowed on or within 10 feet of the Gardner Lake Fire lane.

All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.
