AREA A[red oak]: Harvest all orange marked trees within designated boundaries. (103 acres)

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- Decking of wood allowed along the Gardner Lake Fire Lane as long as the decked wood does not extend out onto the road surface.

Seasonal restrictions:

> Dry summer logging chance after July 15th. Oak wilt restrictions.

BMP's:

No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands except during frozen conditions.

Private Land:

No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.
