## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**AREA A** [Red Oak]: Harvest all merchantable oak and mixed hardwood within the designated boundaries except for 1) green marked trees (leave tree marking). 2) All conifers. 3) all aspen. All un-merchantable stems >1", except aspen and conifers, shall be severed. (29 acres)

#### Access:

- No new roads permitted. Reconstruction of existing woods roads required.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from county forest administrator.

# Seasonal Restrictions:

- No harvesting activity permitted from April 1 through July 15. Oak wilt restriction.
- Dry summer logging chance. Harvesting operations allowed only when soils are dry enough to support equipment.

#### Slash

- Proposed Oak burn site: No slash will be allowed within 10' of the residual trees and no large slash piles will be allowed onsite.
- Logger is encouraged to leave large tops on site away from residual trees.

All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

# MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

**Area A**: This is a 108-year-old red oak sawtimber stand scheduled for a shelterwood and root rake scarified with a good acorn crop. The harvest area is comprised of sandy loam soils. Topography varies from level to moderate with some steep slopes. Dry summer logging chance after July 15<sup>th</sup> oak wilt restriction.
