CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A [Northern Hardwoods]: Harvest all orange marked trees between green marked gaps within the designated boundaries. Within the green marked gaps (80-110' canopy gaps, 1-2/acre) harvest all merchantable trees. Site maintenance required within the gaps: sever all un-merchantable stems. (40 acres)

Access, roads, and landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.

Seasonal restrictions:

- No harvesting activity permitted from April 1 through July 15. Oak wilt restriction.
- Dry summer logging chance after the July 15th oak wilt restriction. Harvesting operations allowed only when soils are dry enough to support equipment.

Slash:

• Contractor is encouraged to leave large tops in gaps to help discourage deer browsing hardwood seedlings.

All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

Area A: is a northern hardwood stand scheduled for a gap and thin. Area A is on level to gently rolling topography on loamy sand soils with dry summer logging chance after the July 15th oak wilt restriction.
