

Eligible Participants

- First time offenders
- Individuals arrested for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia or Possession of THC (Tetrahydrocannabinols), Possession of Synthetic Cannabinoid, or Drug Paraphernalia
- Participants are only eligible for the program one time.

Program Description

- Successful completion of an online 4 hour Marijuana
 Education Course
- Pay program fee to the Washburn County Justice Programs
- On certain cases, a formal AODA Assessment might be required in lieu of the online education course.

Incentives to Participate

- Criminal Charges may not be filed by the District Attorney's Office
- Maintain eligibility for Financial Aid for postsecondary education
- Change unwanted behavior
- Avoid possible jail time and additional court costs
