No Biomass Harvesting Allowed.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A[aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen and mixed hardwood. Reserve all oak and conifers. Aspen maintenance required. (82 acres)

AREA B[oak]: Harvest all merchantable aspen, mixed hardwood and oak <12"DBH. Reserve all conifers and oak >12"DBH. No harvesting activity from April 1 through July 15. Oak wilt restriction. (3 acres)

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- Upon completion of the sale, the contractor must close access roads with earthen berms in the original location and specifications (double berm).

BMP's:

- Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands or ephemeral ponds except during frozen conditions.
- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands or ephemeral ponds.

Private Land:

- No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.

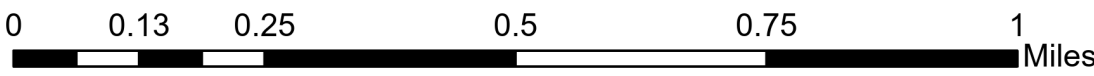
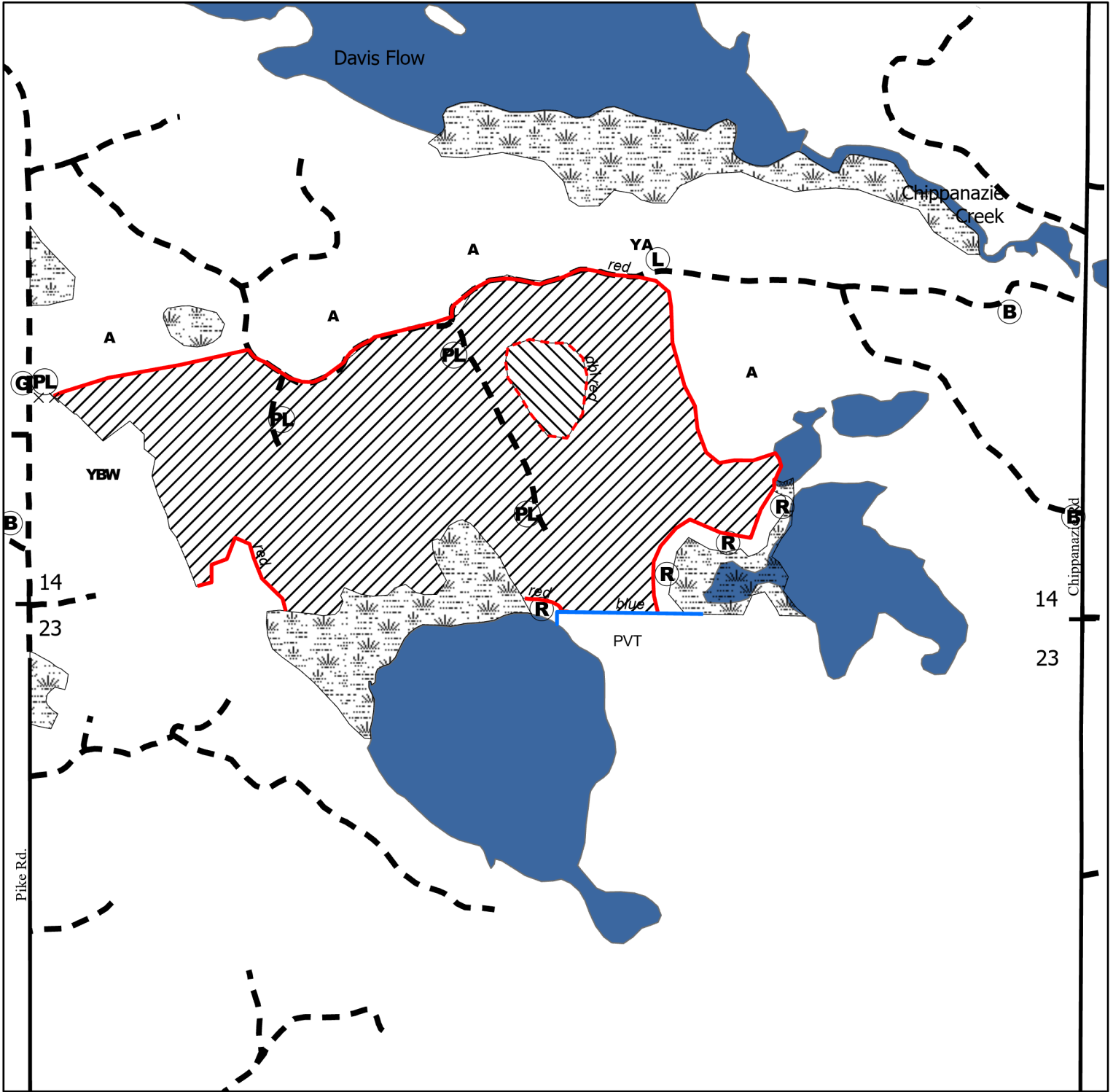
All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

AREA A: is a 49-year-old aspen stand scheduled for an aspen regeneration harvest. Level to rolling topography on loamy sand soils with a dry summer logging chance. **AREA B:** is an oak stand scheduled for a logger's select thinning on loamy sand soils with a dry summer logging chance after July 15th.
