CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A[N. Hdwd]: Harvest all orange marked trees. (79 acres)

AREA B[N.Hdwd]: Harvest all merchantable mixed hardwood within the designated boundaries except for 1) teal marked trees (leave trees), 2) all aspen and 3) all conifers. All un-merchantable stems >1", except aspen and conifers, shall be severed. (3 acres)

AREA C[aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen and mixed hardwood. Reserve all conifers and oak. Aspen maintenance required. (11 acres)

Access, roads & landings:

- Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- New road construction is optional, and is limited to proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Due to topography and or drainage patterns, County Forestry staff will lay out new roads and landing sites.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- A temporary pole ford shall be utilized for skidding across wetland/drainage where indicated on timber sale map during frozen conditions. Removal of this ford shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
- Gate to sale area shall be closed during non-working hours.

BMP's:

- Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands except during frozen conditions.
- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands, ephemeral ponds and intermittent drainage.

Survey Monuments

- Avoid government survey monument illustrated on prospectus map.

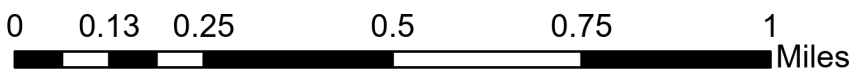
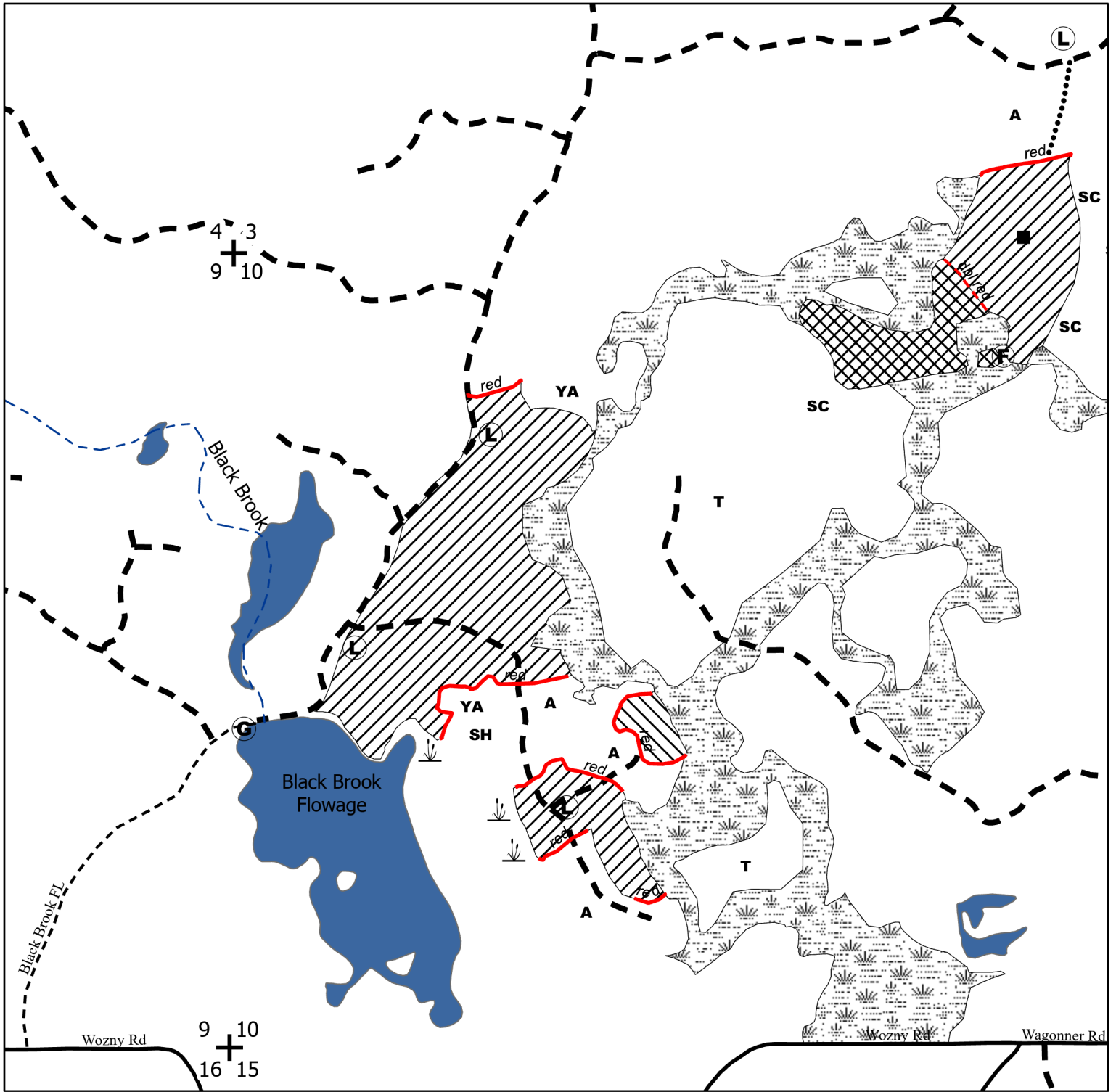
All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

AREA A: is a northern hardwood stand scheduled for a single tree selection to improve the quality of pole sized sugar maple in the understory. Level to rolling topography on silt loam soils with frozen ground conditions required. **AREA B:** is a northern hardwood stand schedule for a shelterwood harvest. Level to rolling topography on silt loam soils with frozen ground conditions required. **AREA C:** is a 68-year-old aspen stand scheduled for an aspen regeneration harvest with aspen maintenance. Level to rolling topography on silt loam soils with frozen ground conditions required.
