3500 Tons Aspen (~1,550 cds.)
400 Tons Oak (~150 cds., 80% red oak and 20% white oak) 2.79 tons/cd
750 Tons Mixed Hdwd. (~ 340 cds. 52% red maple, 29% basswood, 14% sugar maple, 3% white ash, 1% black ash and 1% white birch) 2.2 tons/cd

No Biomass Harvesting allowed.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

AREA A[Aspen]: Harvest all merchantable aspen, mixed hardwood and oak <12"DBH within designated boundaries, except for designated red "X" reserve trees. Reserve all conifers and oak >12"DBH. Aspen maintenance required. [61 acres]

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.
- Upon completion of the sale, the contractor must close access roads where berms exist with earthen berms in the original location and specifications.
- Gates to sale area shall be closed during non-working hours.
- Dry summer logging chance. Harvesting operations allowed only when soils are dry enough to support equipment. Soils can become soft and wet after storms and extended wet spells.

BMP's:

- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands, ephemeral ponds, open water or designated stream channels. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands or 50 feet of ordinary high-water mark of stream, except during frozen conditions.

Recreation:

- Recreation trail surface will have to be restored to at least existing condition and any damaged signs/posts will have to be replaced by the contractor.

Harvesting Modifications:

- Only harvest aspen and white birch within 20 feet of wetland indicated on timber sale map.

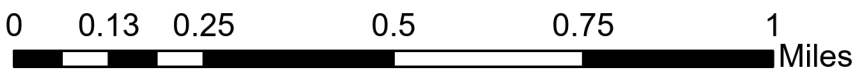
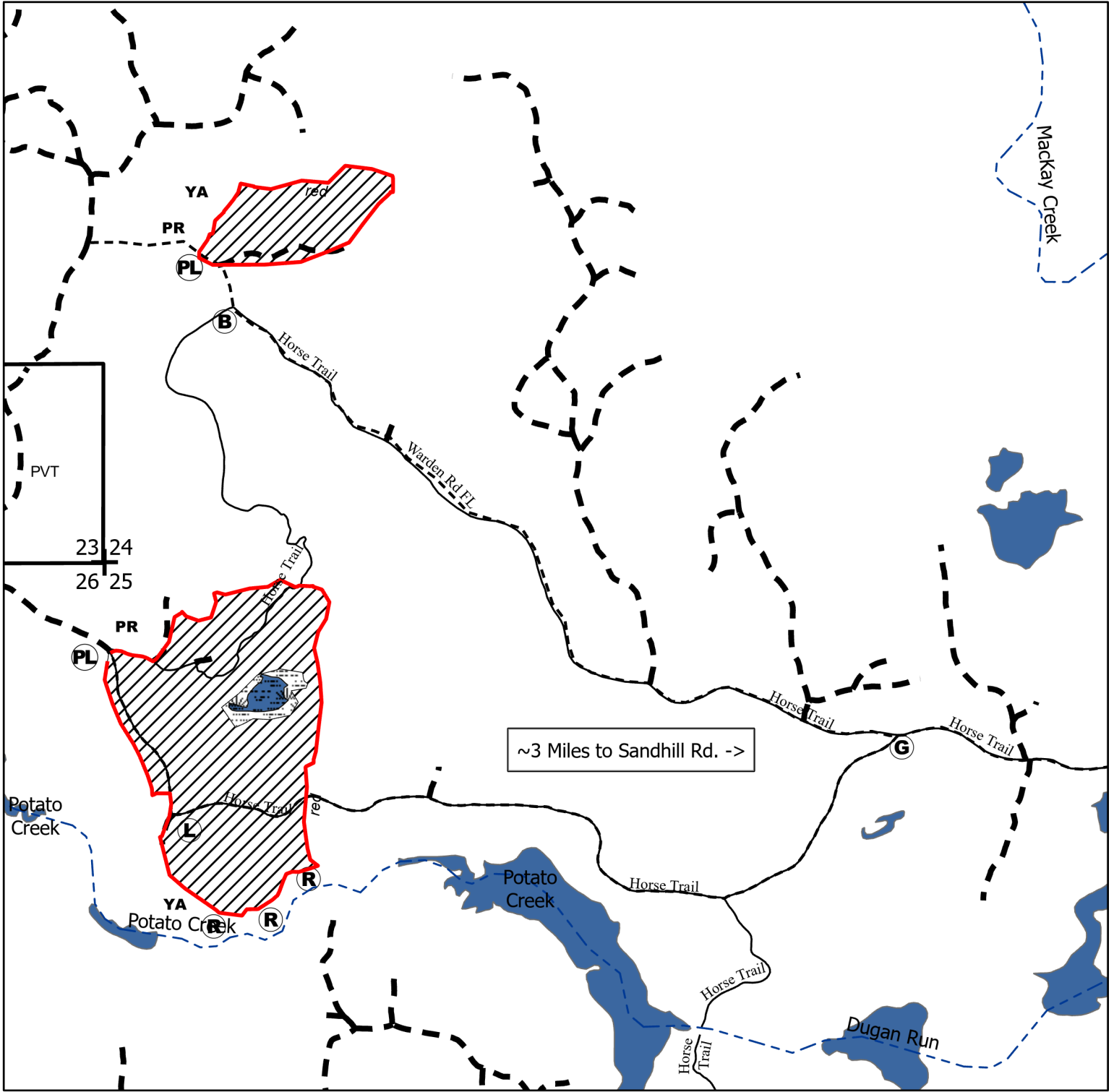

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

AREA A: are 47- and 50-year-old aspen stands scheduled for an aspen regeneration harvest. Level to rolling topography on sandy loam and loamy sand soils with a dry summer logging chance.
