VOLUME, SPECIES & PRICE:

- 950 Tons Oak** (~ 340 Cd. 27% white oak)
- 1,900 Tons Mixed Hardwood** (~880 Cd, 2.15 ton/cd, 45% basswood, 23% red maple, 20% sugar maple, 7% black ash, 5% white ash)
- 120 Tons Aspen** (~50 Cd.)
- 70 MBF Oak** (14% white oak)
- 100 MBF Mixed Hardwood** (70% basswood, 10% red maple, 10% black ash, 5% sugar maple, 5% white ash)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

**AREA A** [Northern Hardwood]: Harvest all merchantable aspen and mixed hardwood within the designated boundaries, reserve all red oak and white pine. (33 acres)

**AREA B** [Red oak]: Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. (19 acres)

**Area C** [Northern Hardwood]: Harvest all merchantable aspen and mixed hardwood within the designated boundaries, reserve all yellow birch and red oak/sugar maple over 12 inches. (7 acres)

Access, roads & landings:

- No new roads will be permitted. Reconstruction of existing forest trails will be needed.
- Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the County Forest Administrator.

Seasonal Restrictions:

- Sale operations will be restricted to frozen conditions.

Private land:

- No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land.
- Purchaser is responsible for securing access across any lands not owned by the County prior to bidding.

BMP's:

- No slash will be left in any non-forested wetlands, ephemeral ponds, open water or designated stream channels. Do not operate wheeled or tracked equipment within 15 feet of wetlands except during frozen conditions.
- Do not operate tracked or wheeled equipment within 15 feet of small streams.

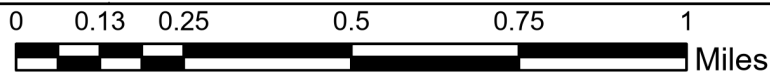
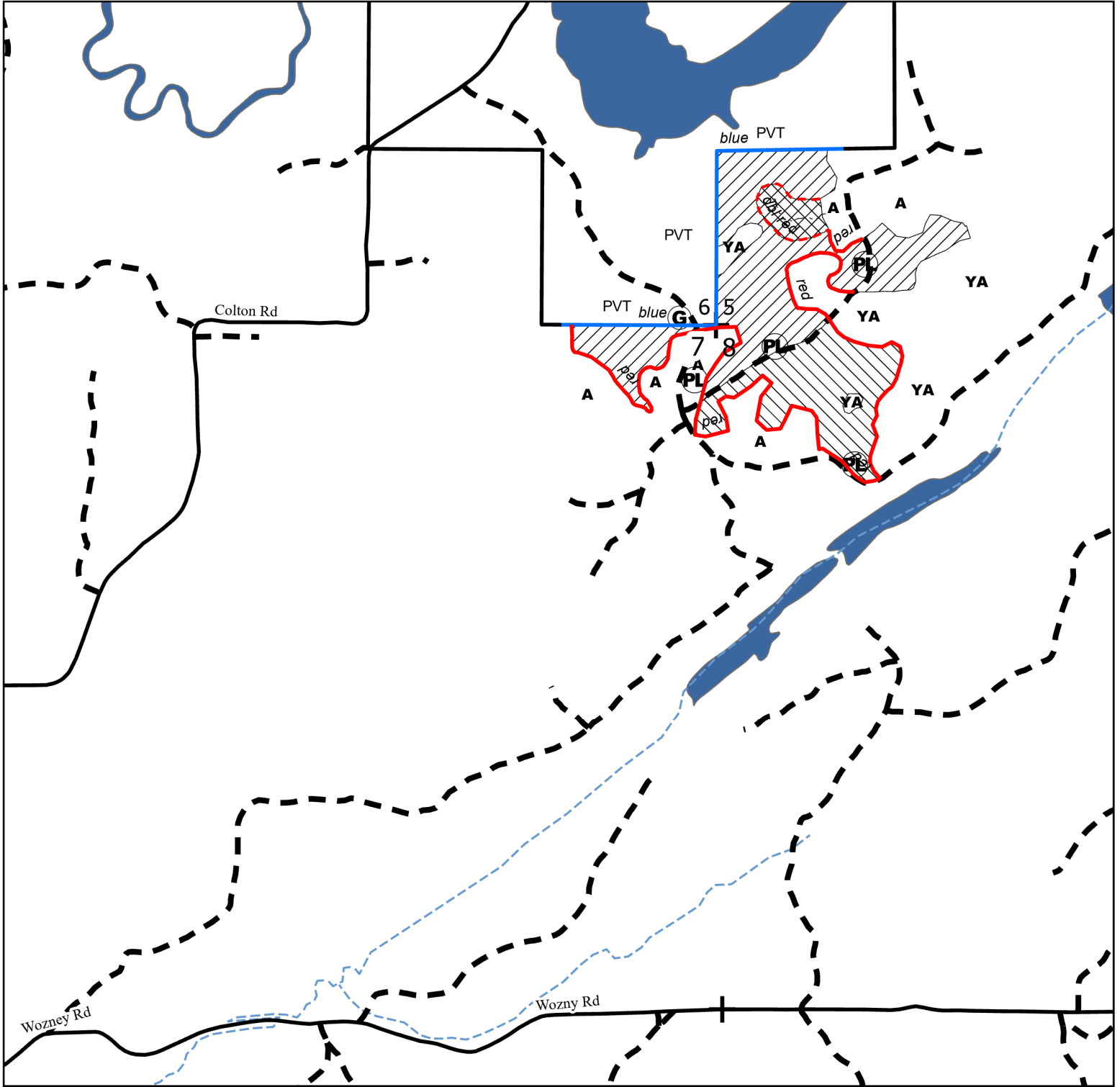
**All additional restrictions listed on the prospectus sheet apply unless otherwise specified.**

MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS

**Area A:** is a moderately well stocked northern hardwood stand scheduled for a seed tree harvest. **Area B:** is a well-stocked red oak stand with a strong northern hardwood understory scheduled for a thinning. **Area C:** is a well-stocked northern hardwood leave tree unit acting as an RMZ around an intermittent stream. All areas are on level to gently rolling topography with some steeper slopes on silt loam soils with frozen ground required.
