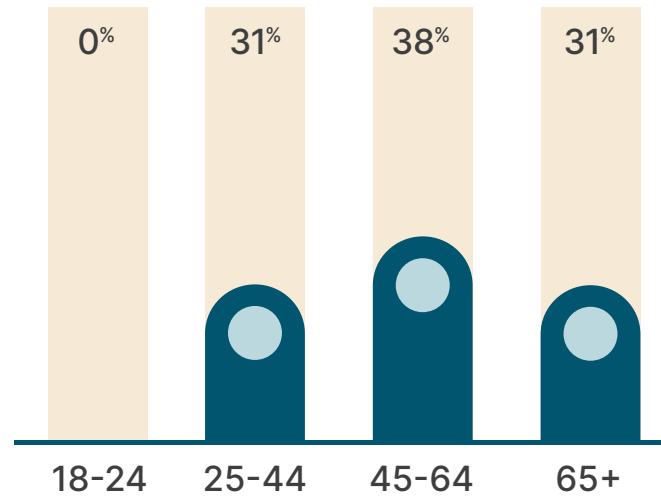

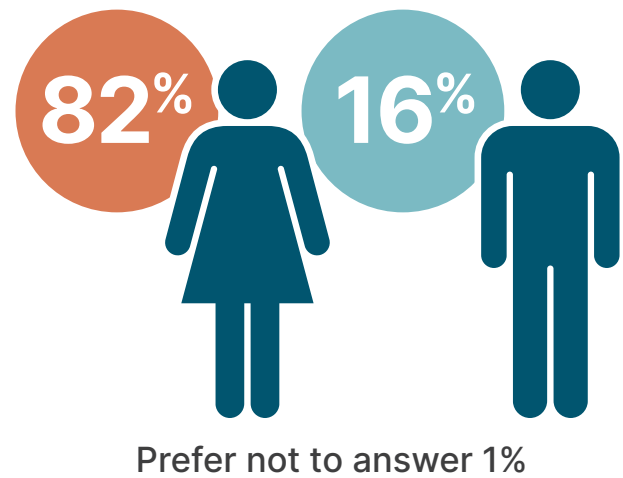

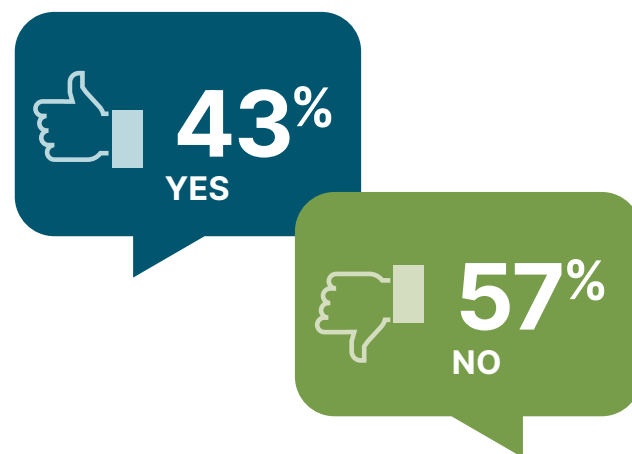
WHAT IS YOUR AGE RANGE?



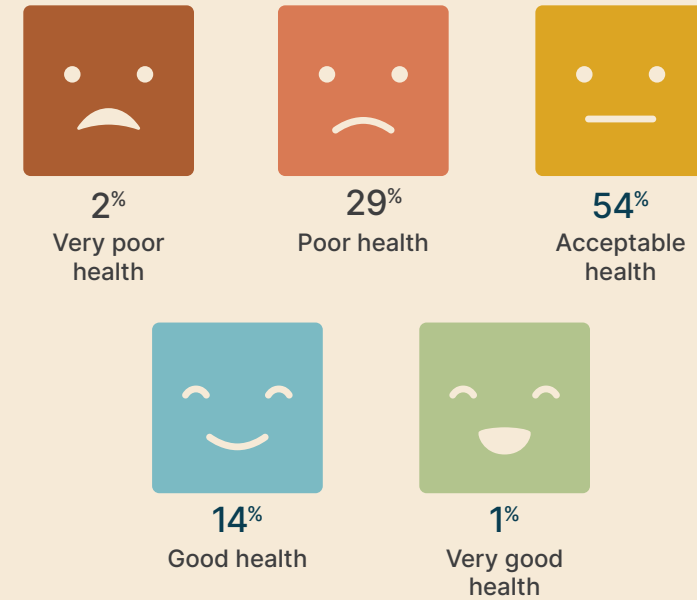
WHAT IS YOUR GENDER?



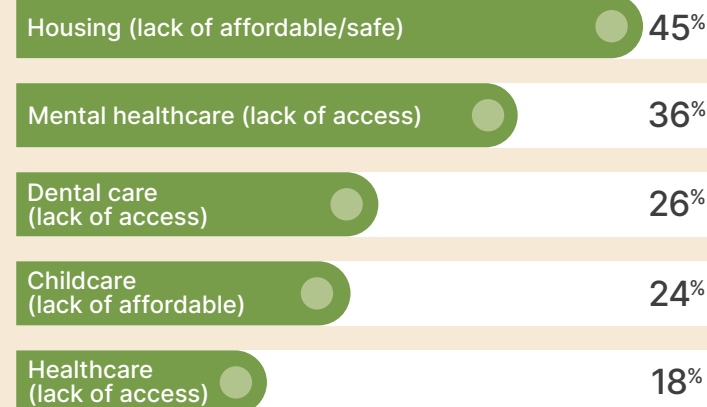

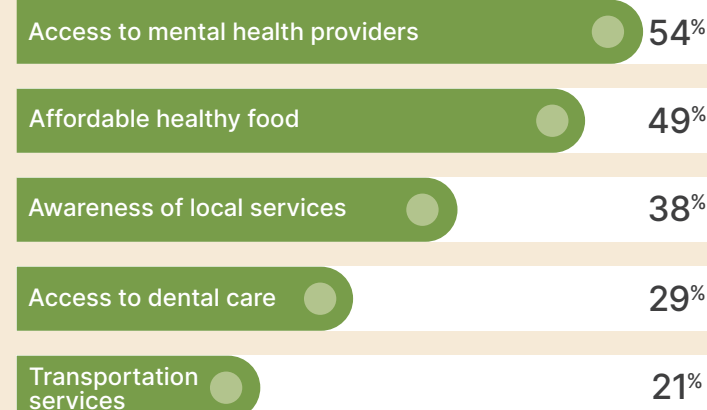
RATE GENERAL HEALTH OF COMMUNITY



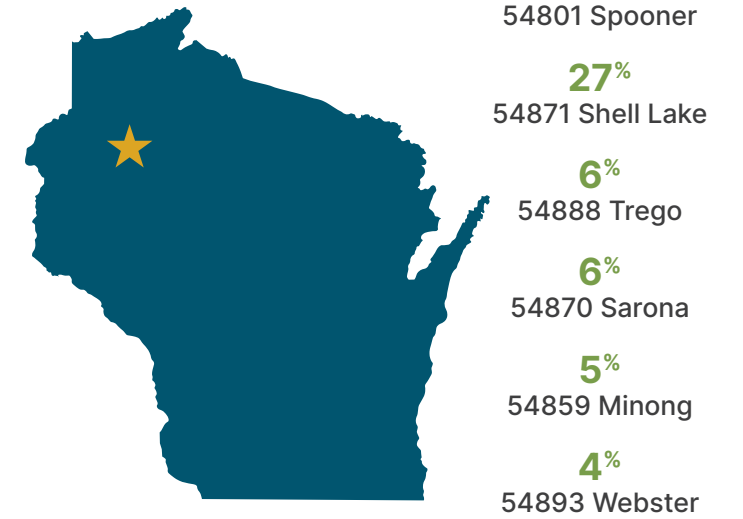
